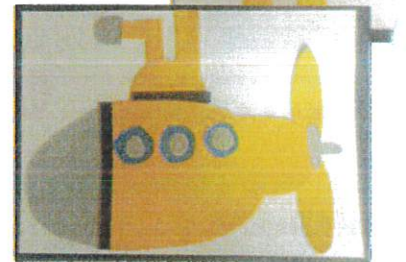
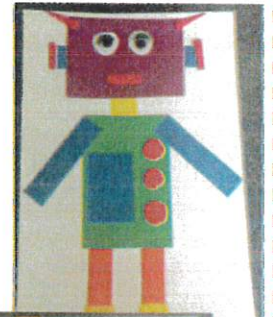
**Can you make a 2D shape picture?**

We have been naming and describing 2D shapes. We would like you to make a picture using 2D shapes. You can draw the shapes or use coloured paper or foam shapes to create your picture. To extend this activity encourage your child to label the shapes they used. Here are some things you could make: a castle, rocket, house, animal, monster, boat, robot, flower, submarine, tractor, giraffe, fox, etc...

Here are some questions to ask your child:

- What picture are you going to make? Why?
- What shapes are you going to use?
- What colour will your shapes be?
- Will some shapes be different sizes? What size?
