



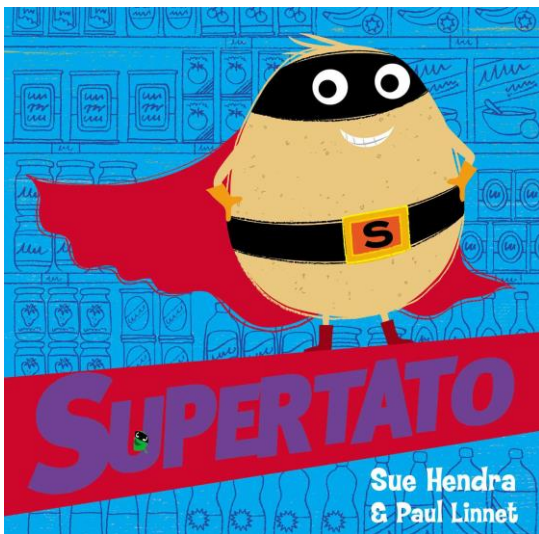
Hi everyone,
